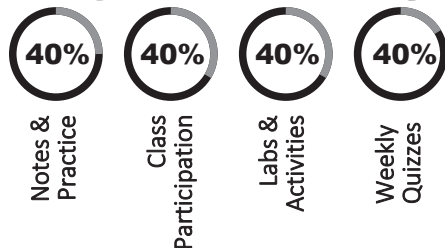

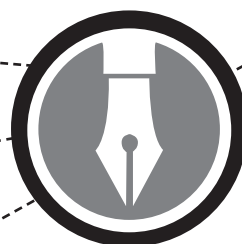

- ***Keep all** notes, activities, and labs in your binder or composition book following the class example. Notes are graded regularly.



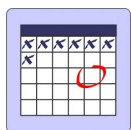
ABSENCE POLICY

*PRACTICE LOG & NOTES

- *Meeting expectations is recorded daily as a stamp on the Practice Log and entered **weekly** as a minor grade into Skyward.
- *Practice Logs are turned in **on Fridays**.
- ***Late stamps** receive a 10 point deduction each day.
- *Practice Logs are the students responsibility.
- ***Notes** are graded on the Practice Log daily and kept in order following the class example.



**HOMEWORK

- *Practice is expected to be **completed in class**.

BLENDED PREFERENCE LEARNING: WHAT IS IT

Learning that blends the best of online, face to face, technology, hands on activity, large group and one to one experience according to the optimization of the content and the need of the learner.

- Students complete a series of surveys to determine their learning preferences, interpersonal skills, and strengths.
- Teacher selects the best method of instruction and practice to optimize the content.
- Students take a pre-assessment to evaluate learning gaps. Teacher and tech tools assist student relearning.
- Student chooses how they want to learn material to meet their own needs when content can be taught best in several ways.
